AGENDA ITEM:	Resolution 2025-094 – A Resolution Approving and Adopting the 2025 update of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Johnson County, Iowa
ACTION:	Approval

Background

The City of Tiffin recognizes the significant threat that natural hazards pose to residents, property, and infrastructure. Federal law, including the **Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act**, requires local jurisdictions to maintain an approved hazard mitigation plan to remain eligible for certain federal disaster assistance and mitigation funding. Johnson County has prepared the **2025 update of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan**, which identifies strategies and actions to reduce long-term risk from hazards such as flooding, severe storms, and other disasters. Adoption of this plan demonstrates the City’s commitment to hazard mitigation and compliance with federal requirements.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of **Resolution No. 2025-094**, which adopts the 2025 update of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Johnson County, Iowa.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-094

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2025 UPDATE OF THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, IOWA

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Tiffin, Iowa, recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within City of Tiffin; and,

Whereas, the site plan/exhibit of the property is attached to this resolution; and,

Whereas, Johnson County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby know as the 2025 update of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Johnson County, Iowa, in accordance with federal laws including the [Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act](#), as amended; the [National Flood Insurance Act of 1968](#), as amended; and the [National Dam Safety Program Act](#), as amended; and,

Whereas, the 2025 update of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Johnson County, Iowa, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City of Tiffin from the impacts of the future hazards and disasters; and,

Whereas, adoption by the City Council of the City of Tiffin demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2025 update of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Johnson County, Iowa.

Now, therefore be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Tiffin, Iowa, that; Section 1. In accordance with Tiffin Municipal Code of Ordinances, the City Council of the City of Tiffin adopts the 2025 update of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Johnson County, Iowa. While content related to the City of Tiffin may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the City of Tiffin to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
