REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL
July 17, 2026

- Work continues to progress on the Forevergreen Road and Jasper Avenue Improvements Project. The contractor is currently working on the storm sewer installation on the west leg of the roundabout.
- Just a friendly reminder, the next event in the Tiffin Summer Social series takes place this Saturday, July 18th. The Ice Cream Social and Movie Night will take place in the Jim Bartels City Park. Ice cream and live music will start at 6:00 p.m. with the movie The Sandlot, starting at dusk. Flyer is attached.
- Rec Fest is less than 30 days away, scheduled for Friday, August 7th and Saturday, August 8th. For this year's event we have moved the 5K to Friday night with a DJ following the race. Saturday will begin later in the afternoon but still packed full of fun. We now have two bands. Trophy Dads and now an opening act Sad Dads. The event will again be held in the open green space area between the New York and Ventnor buildings in the Park Place City Center.
