July 2, 2026**

- Boomerang is back onsite picking up where they left off and installing the rest of the storm sewer along North Park Road Project.
- The next event in the Tiffin Summer Social series takes place on Saturday, July 18th. The Ice Cream Social and Movie Night will take place in the Jim Bartels City Park. Ice cream and live music will start at 6:00 p.m. with the movie starting at dusk. The first event in this series went really well (even with the wet weather we endured that day) and we anticipate this next event being even better.
- Grant Weber and I continue to fine-tune the membership structure for the Recreation Center based on the discussion held at the last work session. We anticipate having another draft for the council to review at the July 21st council meeting.
