CITY ADMINISTRATOR
REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL
April 3, 2026

- One of the changes to the budget process from the passage of HF 718 by the State Legislature is the separate public hearing on the consolidated general fund tax levy. As required, this will be a special city council meeting and will only have this one item on the agenda. The council will hold the public hearing for the proposed levy and after all comments have been made, council will simply close the public hearing and adjourn the meeting. No formal council action is required. We will then wait 15 minutes before proceeding to the work session.
- Work started on the Forevergreen Road and Jasper Avenue Improvements project (roundabout) on Wednesday, April 1st. The weather has played a factor in seeing significant progress within this first week but rain days with spring construction work is somewhat expected.
- Boomerang continues to move along nicely with the next phase of the North Park Road Improvements project. They continue to work on the major underground infrastructure utilities.
- Rathje Construction is anticipating mobilizing back to the Original Town Project the middle of this month. We need to do a walk-through of phase 3 and develop a punchlist for them to work off of as all paving was completed last fall. However, obviously two major items will be the final grading and seeding which will also both be dependent upon the right weather conditions.
- The next Joint Entities Meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 20st at 4:30 p.m. with a reception starting at 4:00 p.m. The meeting will be hosted by University Heights at their City Hall located at 1302 Melrose Avenue.
- Just a friendly reminder that the Tiffin Emergency Responders Association Pancake Breakfast Fundraiser originally scheduled for Sunday, May 3rd has been postponed until a later date.
