REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL – NOTES FOR WORK SESSION ITEMS
November 14, 2025**

- With the new Fire Chief coming on board next year, we should discuss purchasing a new vehicle for that individual. Much like we did a couple of years ago, attached is a quote for a 2026 Chevy Tahoe. Chief Hill will be at the work session to participate in this discussion. I also have this item on the regular agenda pending the work session discussion.
- As a follow up from the October 21st work session, James Watters from MSA will join the meeting virtually to discuss the options (with cost estimates) for the intersections of Croell Avenue and Kimberlite Street as a part of the Highway 6 reconstruction project. Below are the bullet points for the discussion.
 - Fully signalized intersection would cost around \$400,000 – \$435,000 per intersection (either at Croell Avenue or Kimberlite Street)
 - Install just the underground features at Croell Avenue (conduit, loop detector system, pole bases, handholes, etc.) would be around \$80,000 – \$100,000.
