At a Kiosk

If you'd like help or don't have internet access, kiosks and trained personnel will be at City Hall and Springmier Community Library.



At Your Door

If you don't participate online, a Census Bureau interviewer will visit your home. You can answer the same questions then.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ✓ **Two letters and two postcards** from the U.S. Census Bureau in your mail.
- ✓ An **in-person visit** from a U.S. Census Bureau employee if you don't respond online.
- ✓ Short, **simple questions about who lives in your home**—no financial or ID info required.
- ✓ **A few minutes of your time to directly benefit our community.**



All Census workers who visit your home will carry an official **U.S. Census Bureau ID badge** with a photograph and a Department of Commerce watermark.

WHAT NOT TO EXPECT

To stay safe from scams, the Census Bureau will **NEVER**:

- ✗ Ask for your Social Security number, bank information, or payment.
- ✗ Ask you to click links outside the official site: **portal.census.gov/specialcensus**
- ✗ Call, text or email **UNLESS** you have included this information in your completed census survey.
