3. City Administrator's Report – Discussion and Review of FY 2026-2027 Budget.

The FY 2026–2027 budget reflects increased costs in public safety, insurance, fuel, and capital needs, highlighted by expanded police services, continued fire staffing support, preparation for the new recreation center, and strategic investments across parks, roads, utilities, and facilities. Revenue growth is more limited due to recent legislation, but LOST revenues and anticipated special census results are expected to help maintain the \$11.80 tax levy and reduce reliance on the General Fund.
